But she had subsequently had an apologetic letter from the student saying her plans had changed, and she was scheduled to go to college in the town where there was already sorted!

In my own student days I was led the night before an interview to look at some particular history notes, The next day at the interview this information led to my being offered a place at the college, because the professor who interviewed specialised in the information which I had swotted up the night before. Living a life of faith can transform one's life no matter the situation. The modern world tends to pooh-pooh living by faith, which means prayer to the God who created the universe and cares about the welfare of any person He created. Yes there can be trouble but there's spiritual comfort available to anyone who asks. We are coming up to Easter which celebrates God with us. Palm Sunday was everything going for Jesus in popularity, but then it was Good Friday and disaster. But all was triumph in his resurrection on Easter Sunday!

Let us celebrate!

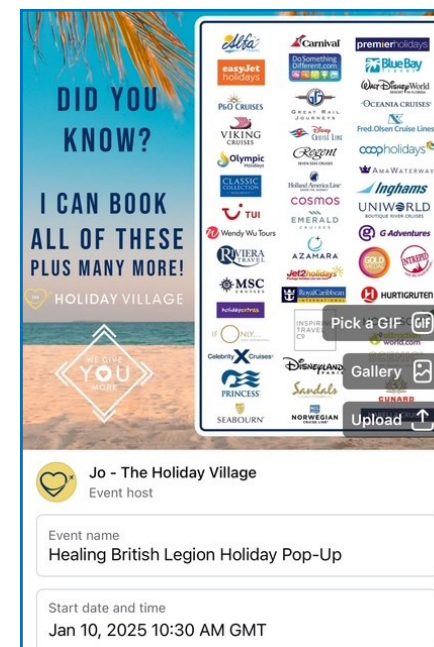

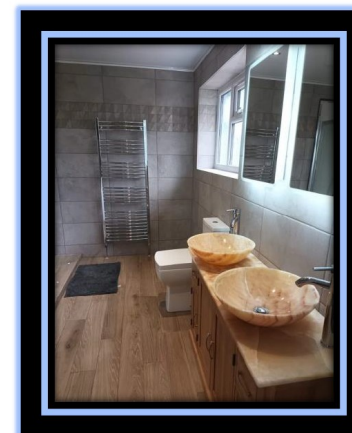
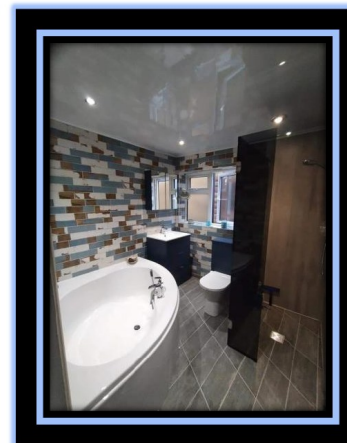

Children in Year 3 and 4 from Healing Primary Academy, have recently teamed up with James, the Canoe River Cleaner, to learn about our local river, the River Freshney. As part of their school work, the children have been learning about the different features of a river and have also been tracking the River Freshney from the source, near Beelsby, to the mouth in Alexandra dock, Grimsby. When we first contacted James, he was very excited by our idea and was keen from the outset to get involved.

His passion for nature and for helping keep our river clean and safe for wildlife are second to none. Over the space of three morning sessions in the glorious March sunshine, the children were involved in 'Giving back to nature', by firstly carrying out a little pick behind Morrisons supermarket in Laceby, before walking the stretch of the river towards Laceby village, taking in the sights and sounds of what is a truly beautiful part of our local area. Here, James, was bombarded by great questions by eager to learn pupils of the school.

Along our walk, the children got to experience first-hand the significance of a natural Blow Well (unique to this part of the world), as well as learning about the importance of our local chalk streams. The children had a fantastic time and have learnt first hand the importance of looking after nature and our local water ways, after all, all rivers lead to the ocean and must be kept free of litter.

James wrote on his personal Facebook page – *'A fantastic bunch of kids who got stuck in, asked plenty of questions, and left me with no doubt that they'll continue to respect the environment as they grow up'.*

HEALING GREEN GROUP

Wow what a lovely warm month, mostly anyway, but probably another sign of the rapid climate change and global warming. A recent report found that the average Spring temperature in the UK had risen by 1.8C since 1970! Long gone are the big freeze-ups, snow and ice that I remember from that time. And well above the 1.5C rise since pre-industrial times that is expected to lead to severe planetary changes if drastic action is not taken to reduce our carbon emissions, etc.

Despite the warmth, the amount of sunshine was actually slightly down on average so my solar panels didn't produce as much as in the past few years and the storms didn't break any records for power generation by the country's wind turbines. So a lot more still needs to be done.

Doing our bit at the Moated Settlement continues. All the trees planted last year and this are budding up nicely and looking happy and healthy. The alders, just bare twigs last January, are now my head height! The aconites and snowdrops flowered well and the "wild" flowers introduced last year are beginning to sprout new leaves.

It is really satisfying to see all the new paths being well used by walkers (with and without dogs) every day. And no sign of litter. Some more paths have been opened up through the trees and bushes around the edges as more people are now using the site. More will be done this year to get the grass under control and the stinging nettles contained. We don't want to eliminate them as they do provide a good habitat for some insects but anyone who wants to walk over the nettles to limit new growth - please do so.

The gate at Clematis Avenue has been taken off the hinges to improve access. Provided that no-one now brings motorised wheeled vehicles onto the site then there will be no need to replace it. Some work on the old boundary fencing is in progress.

Fingers crossed that everyone continues to act responsibly and helps to develop the site as a great local facility for things Green and good for us and the environment.

BEWARE OF SCAMS

Scams are everywhere these days and anyone can be a victim (including you). Whilst banks, the Police and most businesses work hard to protect us from fraud, we have to do as much as we can to avoid scams ourselves too.

Scammers only care about getting sensitive information from us and eventually our money. And a scam could be a letter through the post; a call on your landline or mobile; a text message, WhatsApp message, Facebook post or an email; it could be a fake website, a fake holiday, ticket, investment or more.

So, as I explained at a recent talk about scams at the village hall, we should be alert to a call or message or communication that a) is unexpected, b) is urgent (now! Today! Cannot be missed!), and c) gets us emotional - which normally means excited (you've won a holiday!) or scared/worried (you'll be cut off! I need help now! Your bank account is at risk! You'll be arrested!).

What do you do if that call or message worries you, sounds urgent and you think might not be real (i.e. it's a scam)? The best advice is simply to STOP or take a five minute pause. Think it through. Ask a friend. Get some advice. Do some research. Take the upper hand and don't just follow through on what you've been told (by the possible scammer).

Searching on Which? www.which.co.uk for scams has plenty of advice and I recommend signing up to their scams newsletter. We have bits of advice on our own www.nelwatch.org.uk website too. Be alert. Stay safe. Say No to scams.
