The July meeting was held at the Village Hall, as usual.

Highways/footpaths

The Parish Council had sent out some polite requests asking residents to cut back hedges etc. and a big thank you to residents for doing this for us. The PC had also been consulted on the Winter Service Plans by NELC.

HEALING GREEN GROUP

Not too much to say concerning activities in Healing this month. Even though it's still pretty green the ground is extremely dry and many of the smaller plants are beginning to die back earlier than they should with a bit of rain. The planter by the Healing sign on Stallingborough Road has been sorted out and some flowers put in. Please feel free to add a little water if you are passing. The other planters are being well looked after and giving a good display. Thanks to all involved with those. The black-thorns forming the narrow section of path at the Moated Settlement are being trimmed back. Losing a few sloes, which have already formed, but still plenty elsewhere around the site. Fewer stinging nettles but the grass is doing very well and plenty of people are walking around and enjoying the environment.

Even though the cereal crops in the local fields are going nice and brown and we have already seen some harvesting, the yield is probably quite low as the grain hasn't fully grown. With record high temperatures continuing and now our third heatwave of the year, there are certainly going to be some very strange, and probably unpleasant, consequences over the next few months.

So, much as expected, Yorkshire and parts of North Lincolnshire were declared drought areas and a hosepipe ban introduced. Probably not too long before the rest of Lincolnshire follows suit. Fortunately, my rainwater harvesting system is really paying dividends at the moment.

At least the periods of high wind and long hours of sunshine have done pretty well for the UK power generation. However, this still only provided, on average, 44.8% of the country's energy requirements with 21.5% still coming from burning gas. The remainder was from nuclear, wood and a little hydro.
