

### View from the Pew

What governs the decisions you make? The way we make decisions about our lives is crucial for everyday actions. One of the choices is to respond to the spiritual aspect of our being. The existence of the spiritual has been an integral part of our existence, and the response can be seen in many of the religions of the world.

One of the factors in our country is in the decline in Church attendance in Christianity. Why is this happening? Somehow people don't find the answer to their spiritual needs in Church anymore but the need is still there. It is ignored because emphasis in our society seems to be on practical things, rather than spiritual things. It is so much easier to just live for oneself than to respond to the deeper sense of "something more".

So what is that "something" more?

Having a spiritual aspect is an integral part of our personality. The importance of our spiritual responses can be seen in the devotion of other religions in our country, which have their basis in the people who are here with an origin in spiritual things from other countries.

What does Christianity offer? The core is the life and death of Jesus, and the transformation of his disciples by the coming of the Holy Spirit—a spiritual experience that transformed their lives and made them feel "we have to go out and tell what we have experienced—the sense of the living God as a basis for all our living". This can be mirrored in our experience.

I went to Israel many years ago. I had a hotel room overlooking the side of the temple. I woke up in the middle of the night and the room was full of light and a Presence. The message coming to me was "this is where it all happened and you need not doubt anymore".

And I haven't.


