HEALING GREEN GROUP

It's the time of year to sit back and enjoy the greenery and the wildlife.

Despite the record breaking dry Spring most of the countryside is still looking exceptionally green and healthy with a good variety of wild flowers coming into bloom. Unfortunately, some of the very small trees planted this year at the Moated Settlement have now succumbed to the lack of water and too much sunshine but most are hanging-on, somewhere in the long grass.

Thanks to those who have added some new plants to the various planters around the village, and there is still an opportunity to do some more - and keep them watered!

This week Yorkshire was declared to be a drought zone by the Environmental Agency, which didn't really come as much of a surprise. With no sustained, heavy rain in the weather forecast for the foreseeable future it is quite likely that Lincolnshire will not be too far behind. This is probably another sign of the on-going massive climate change.

One thing that the hot, dry conditions has done is to produce a (potentially) massive crop of apples. Last year, one of our trees only yielded 6 apples after the flowers fell off very early on. This year there must be around 200 apples forming as none of the flowers fell. If they continue to grow, the tree is likely to collapse under the weight!! That is, if the deer don't come back. We had a lovely surprise one morning when a mother Reeve's Muntjac deer was watching over her fawn (about the size of a large rabbit), both tucking into the baby apples with considerable relish!

Also, for the first time ever, I have kiwi fruits forming on the bush I got from the old Healing Nursery when it closed down, quite a few years back. And the fig tree is a mass of leaves but no fruit yet.

Finally, on a national scale - it's been quite a windy few weeks. This has been great for power generation from the country's wind turbines but didn't eliminate the need to burn gas in our power stations. A really good article on the BBC news website went into this in some detail. The National Grid is paying a lot of money for very large windfarms in Scotland to throttle back and not produce power during these very windy periods - as the grid system just isn't big enough to transport the power away! Oh dear!! And there are solar farms which aren't even connected yet, and work is only just getting going on very large battery storage farms. Better late than never, I suppose.

It seems to me that as a minister I face it quite often. This is not a nine to five job, it is facing a dilemma, and so it pulls you in all directions at the same time. What do you do with it, fuss a lot about your priorities in life and while sometimes when speed first is not always that easy.

An example of this is a minister friend we went to visit a few years ago. When we arrived at his manse one of his church members had been involved in a road traffic accident and was asking for him in hospital. They did not know what to do for the best as he knew we were coming and did not want to disappoint us. But his church member needed him. When we arrived, I told him to go as we can meet again another time. It might be serious and not to go would be wrong. He needed to attend to the church member.

Life is not also particularly easy as we have so many commitments, and sometimes we don't know which way to turn but if we ask God, he will show us the right way to turn every time.
