View from the Pew

I hope you all enjoyed a peaceful Christmas and a hopeful start to the New Year. Our own Christmas was a quiet one—once my final Christmas service was complete—and we welcomed the New Year by watching the London fireworks on television. People often ask me what feels most special about Christmas. My usual answer is that my favourite day is Boxing Day, because it means all the extra services and preparations are finally finished. Only joking... mostly.

For many of us as Methodists, we move straight from the joy and intensity of Christmas into the solemnity of the Covenant Service—a moment of deep recommitment. If we take its words seriously, they can be both profound and far-reaching. Yet we rarely give ourselves time to rest, breathe, and reflect on the significance of Christmas or any of our great Christian celebrations. We compress events that unfolded over years into a few short days, and then hurry on to the next thing.

Life in general isn't much different. We pack our days and weeks full because there is always something else waiting just around the corner. In all that rushing, we lose the chance to savour the moment we're actually in. As someone who is dyslexic, I know this all too well. My particular form means that once I've planned something, my brain sometimes decides the job is already done—even when it isn't. I have to consciously stop myself from leaping ahead to the next task before finishing the one in front of me. It creates its challenges, but with practice I manage to work my way through.
