

View from the Pew

Reflections on a Month of Highs and Lows

This past month has been a real mixture of emotions for our family, filled with both challenges and moments of immense joy. Our daughter, who is currently studying at Nottingham Trent University, has faced significant health difficulties. She has had to visit A&E several times due to persistent and worsening pain in her knees, a problem she has struggled with for several years. The pain has become so severe that it is now causing further complications, partly because of the painkillers she has been taking.

Amidst these difficult times, we were blessed with a truly uplifting experience. We attended an extraordinary service at our daughter's church, where she was baptised by full immersion. The event, held at Trent Vineyard church on a Sunday evening, was attended by around 1,000 people and saw 38 individuals being baptised. The service was made even more powerful by about ten moving testimonies, each one a testament to faith and perseverance. Remarkably, this celebration took place just hours after our daughter had been released from her latest stay in hospital.

These experiences have come to define our lives recently—one moment we find ourselves receiving anxious calls from Lucy as she is en route to A&E, and the next we are witnessing something truly special, a reminder that God is present even amid crises.

During such turbulent times, I am often reminded of the well-known 'Footprints in the Sand' poem. In particular, the closing lines resonate deeply with me, where the writer, speaking to Jesus, says, "When I needed you most you have not been there for me." Jesus responds, "The time when you have only seen one set of footprints is when I carried you."

This poem serves as a powerful reminder that we need never be afraid, for God is always by our side, especially during our most difficult moments.

May God bless you all.

We have had such a good response to our dedicated fundraising for Harley and so far have been paying for his specialist swimming lessons at a local leisure centre through Lincs Inspire.


We will get an update for a future edition and let you know what the PC will do with the balance of the funds when the swimming lessons have been completed.


