## POLICE REPORT

### Wolds Ward Healing Update

#### Crime

There were fifty one reported crimes across the Wolds Ward during August. The following offences were reported in Healing.

Between 19<sup>th</sup> July & 2<sup>nd</sup> August, an attempt was made to force two padlocks on a garage door at a property on Poplar Road. No entry was made.

Around teatime on 18<sup>th</sup> August, damage was caused to a window at the scout hut on Poplar Road after children were seen throwing stones at the building.

## **View from the Pew**

After the end of the Second World War my family went to Felixstowe to visit relatives. We stayed with an Aunt May and Uncle Fred. Nearby there were another aunt and uncle, Annie and Bob. As a young child I was very puzzled as to why, when we were there, we could not go and see both sets of families together. I soon came to realise that the two families did not talk to each other. About 30 years later Uncle Bob was in hospital, unlikely to live, and I gathered my Aunt May did go to visit him and talked to him. I never did discover what the dispute was so that the two families never talked to each other.

Are you in dispute with members of your family, work colleagues or team members? What was the cause of your dispute and why can you not resolve it? So often we become entrenched emotionally with such a dispute. And then across the world of course, there are nations in dispute with each other. The result is war, killing and dispute.

Jesus was once challenged as to what was the most important law. This was a trick question to get him punished by the lawyers of the day. What was his answer? It was that we should love God with all our heart, soul, strength and mind. And we must love our neighbours as much as we love ourselves.

In other words, in all our relationships we are to care and love people regardless of how we feel about them. Can you manage that? What a change it would bring to the world, to our community, to our family if we lived by these rules.

Think about this poem by Dave Hopwood

*Humility is not about being a doormat.  
Or a 'yes' person or a pushover...  
Instead it is knowing our place in the world –  
looking at the sky and seeing the vastness of it,  
yet knowing that within that massive universe  
we are precious people...  
Selfish ambition  
might fast track us to the top.  
But it can also destroy our true humanity.  
Humility is that warm, gentle light  
which always eclipses arrogance.  
The Son of righteousness can set us free.*
