




Zip Wire and Parks Update!

View from the pew

On a recent walk, the footpath through the field consisted of dry, dusty, compacted dirt; well-trod and hard-packed. In stark contrast to the lifeless path, on either side grew the crops; strong, healthy and green. Those crops were not there by accident, they were the fruit of the partnership of the farmer's toil in the natural environment and God who has hard-coded growth into tiny seeds.

Sometimes, that is how my life seems; a familiar path compressed by the regularity of ritual or routine. The path of life is necessary, of course, but the real gold of who I am lies in the wider field, in the crops and the fruits of my character. I tend to place too much emphasis on the path with questions such as 'Where am I going?' while perhaps neglecting the more important consideration of looking around and asking, 'What is growing?' or 'Who am I becoming?'

We reap what we sow; be that agriculturally or in personal values, words spoken or deeds done. In the Old Testament book of Hosea, we read, 'For they sow the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind.' As I write, the UK finds itself in the midst of a political whirlwind which has culminated in the resignation of Prime Minister Johnson, the consequence of the sowing of much bluster and wind, perhaps. However, it is too easy to look beyond myself and judge the crops of others, and it is a temptation always to be avoided. What of my own field?

Later in Hosea, we read, 'Sow righteousness for yourselves, reap the fruit of unfailing love'. 'Righteousness' sounds very holy, unattainable and pious, but it is, in essence, no more than being 'right with God'. Am I 'right with God'? Do I spend time with him in prayer? How is our dialogue? Do I practice the presence of God in my daily work and rest? Do I seek to know him better? It is not a case of doing one hundred good deeds before breakfast, so much as it is about cultivating a heart that is devoted to God. And a heart that is devoted to God will also be filled with love towards others, because God *is* love.

Socrates is credited with saying, 'Beware the barrenness of a busy life'. Sowing righteousness, being right with God, may require you to resist the urge to cram more activity into your week and allow your spirit to grow towards fruitfulness. How can you redeem the space, clear the stones, and sow righteousness and love?

How to avoid electrical fires



Chargers and devices...

- Only buy manufacturer approved chargers for your products. Don't be tempted to buy cheaper, unbranded and possibly counterfeit chargers from traders or online.
- Always follow the manufacturer's instructions.
- All manufacturers and importers are required to ensure that electrical items they supply are fitted with UK three-pin plugs with the proper fuse.
- Charge your device when you are awake, not when you are sleeping.
- Switch off at the socket and unplug once you have finished charging.
- Keep all chargers clear of fabrics or anything that could cover them. Do not have your charging device on your bed while you sleep.

E- Cigarettes...

- Always use a compatible charger and follow the instructions provided by the manufacturer carefully.
- Do not over tighten the atomiser when connecting an e-cigarette to the charger.
- Ensure that e-cigarettes are not left charging for long periods of time. Remove the battery when charged to prevent overcharging.
- Never leave e-cigarettes plugged in overnight or when you are out of the house.
