### Wolds Ward Healing Update November 2023

#### Crime

There were thirty seven reported crimes across the Wolds Ward during October. The following offences were reported in Healing.

We will be looking to hopefully get the serving hatch enlarged during the Christmas period and the PC is looking to decorate through the Hall during 2024.

#### Other

During the month the Chairman and Clerk had held meetings with outside bodies such as contractors, NELC etc. and also attended the ERNLLCA District Meeting for NE Lincs, which was hosted by Healing. The Chairman of the PC is also Chair of the Board of Governors at Healing Academy and has been attending meetings in this role.

Parish Council notes continued.....

### Parks and Land Management

The Council has now put in place a management plan for the Moated Site and sheep will no longer be present on the site. Part of the fence around the inner perimeter of the site, along with the barbed wire, will now be removed and areas of nettles will be treated very early in the new year and certain areas cut back to allow access for residents to use the site.

All other sites were being maintained as usual with grass cutting coming to a stop on the parks for the winter months and remedial works to the bowling green being carried out between seasons. The tennis court nets will now be stored for winter and the court surface cleaned and made ready for Spring 2024.

### Finance

Usual finance items were dealt with and staff appraisals were also being organised and completed as part of the annual staff review programme.

The Council will set its budget and precept amount for the coming year 24/25 when it meets in January 2024.

## View from the Pew

What do you want for Christmas? It's a common enough question at this time of year, isn't it? Myself, I would gladly forgo all gifts of socks and shortbread biscuits in the world for the chance of peace on earth; I'm sure you feel the same.

In the Bible, Psalm 22 opens with a haunting question that mirrors the tumult of our times, 'My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?' In the heartbreaking images of war and destruction that flood our screens, it is a cry that seems to rise from the dust of a fractured world. And in those moments, we echo the voices that cry out, 'Do not be far from me, for trouble is near' (Psalm 22 vs 11)

Yet within this cry lies the profound truth of Christmas, the whisper of 'Emmanuel' amidst the cacophony of conflict. The Christmas message, often lost amid the sparkle and cheer, is fundamentally about God entering the muck and mess of our fractured world. The meaning of Christmas is not that we are given an escape from the darkness but that we are promised a companion within it. In the birth of Jesus, God declared, 'I am with you'. Not distant. Not detached. God with us. In the child in the manger. We too are invited to join in the angel chorus, a prayer for peace on earth and goodwill to all people. It is a prayer that rises not from a place of naïve hope but from a deep well of defiant faith. It acknowledges the darkness and yet dares to light a candle, to believe that this light cannot be overcome by the darkness.

Let it begin with me, let it begin with us. In the daily choices we make, in the love we give, in the hope we share, in every act of kindness, in every gesture of peace, may we embody the truth that God is not far off. He is here, Emmanuel.


The main projects to be progressed are:
