View from the Pew

Are you weary of watching the news across the world? It seems to be a never-ending list of wars, terrorist actions, power struggles and hatred between different races. And in our land, there are conflicts between political parties, endless strikes, the rich exploiting the poor and those who want to care for the ecology and those whose desire is to strip the land of resources. The United Kingdom is rapidly becoming a group of independent nations who want their own way.

In your own personal life what conflicts are there? Perhaps personal relationships which are failing, differences between the young and old in a family, desire for possessions at the expense of others. Or maybe conflict with an employer.

How can all this conflict and hatred be resolved, and the world become a place of peace and goodwill. Nelson Mandela, the great reconciler in South Africa, said *'In the end reconciliation is a spiritual process which requires more than a legal framework. 
