## HEALING PARISH COUNCIL NOTES FOR MARCH 2023

The February 2023 meeting was held on 14th February 2023.

There were some members of the public present at the meeting as well as Ward Cllr. representation from NELC.

### Highways/footpaths

Matters reported to NELC were ongoing but no rapid progress is expected due to staffing numbers at NELC, reorganisation of departments and budget setting and upcoming elections.

### Planning

The following planning applications were considered and the agreed comments of the Parish Council shown below each one. These comments are then submitted to NELC as required:

### **Planning Application Reference: DM/0016/23/FUL**

**Proposal: Alterations to install three new windows to the side elevation, two windows to the rear elevation, erect a canopy to the rear elevation and erect a detached workshop and packaging store (Amended Plans received 31st January 2023 to install two additional windows to the rear and reduce canopy)**

**Location: Subzero Unit 2 Genesis Way Healing**

*No objections.*

**Location: Land Off Energy Park Way Grimsby**  
**Planning Application Reference: DM/1103/22/FUL**  
**Proposal: Proposed tyre pyrolysis plant including 20m high flue, associated buildings, treatment and storage plant and tanks, conveyors, chillers, silo, ground mounted solar array, emergency flare, car parking, security fencing and landscaping**  
*A presentation had been received on this application at a previous meeting of the Council and no objections were raised.*

#### Green Agenda Group

The Group continued to meet and had successfully chipped over 60 Christmas Trees at the village hall and received donations from residents.

#### Parish Council Matters

The new Model Code of Conduct had been received from NELC and this would be considered for adoption by Healing PC. The Parish Council considered a clothing bank at the site of the Village Hall and this is being progressed. The Clerk reminded all members that elections were due to take place in May 2023 with all Town and Parish Councils locally up for re-election.

#### Village Hall

A larger hatch between the kitchen and the main hall had been agreed and this would now be progressed, along with looking at a hearing loop for the Hall. Boarding had now been installed in the toilet areas.

### View from the pew

I am watching a series on TV called 'Build your dream home in the country'. It is about couples and families giving up their mainly suburban life and moving to what they see as a more idyllic lifestyle. This involves building or renovating a rundown property or buying a plot of land to build on. For all the people I have seen, up to now, this is a conscious decision to seek a better life, to rethink, in a lot of cases, what is important to them and to give them a less stressful existence. Often to reach the stage of moving into this idyllic home in the country there is a great deal of stress and even hardship. In the end every one of them has said it was worth it because they are in a better place.

In our lives we sometimes need to reflect on what are our priorities, what is best for us and what is important to us. Often, we go through life just trying to make it from one day to the next, it seems we are just existing to see what tomorrow brings. To stop this daily grind of jumping from one thing to another takes a big jump and time we feel we have not got the energy or strength, but in truth we need to find that space just to think about what is important to us. We can then make plans to move into that better place.

We are now in the period of the Christian calendar of Lent, a time when traditionally we give something up for the six weeks up to Easter. For some it is a time of reflection to readjust our priorities and to rethink what is important to us, just like in the TV programme, but in our Christian walk as well. There are a number of ways we go about this and just as in the TV programme everyone is different, but the goal is the same, to make our lives better and therefore make the world a better place.
